School-wide Positive Behaviour for Learning Plan

Be Responsible

Be Respectful

Students who follow our school rules will be rewarded for showing positive behaviour using rewards which are:

FREE AND FREQUENT:

- Receive house points, stickers, dojos, other class rewards and specific positive feedback.
 Receive playground tokens for entries into Assembly draws for free lunches.
 Share quality work with peers, other teachers and Mrs Champion.

INTERMITTENT

- Receive Assembly awards for being "Learner of the Week".
- Have parents informed about their fantastic behaviour.
- Participate in weekly or fortnightly active play or social times (determined by Stages) if they have 100% positive behaviour for the week or fortnight.

STRONG AND LONG:

- . Students who have remained on GREEN or YELLOW level consistently for 5 weeks qualify to attend Reggie Rewards Sessions held in weeks 5 and 10.
- Reggie Rewards will be a negotiated reward developed with students, but may include trivia, movie afternoon, mini-raiders, games session etc.
- Attendence at Reggie Rewards sessions will also lead to achieving Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum Reggie
 Ribbons and a Platinum Pin depending the number of Reggie Rewards sessions they have attended.

 2 x Reggie Rewards sessions = a SILVER Reggie Ribbon

 4 x Reggie Rewards sessions = a SILVER Reggie Ribbon

 6 x Reggie Rewards sessions = a GOLD Reggie Ribbon

 8 x Reggie Rewards sessions = a FLATINUM pin awarded at end of year.

Working to Correct Behaviours

Students who exhibit MINOR (see attached list) inappropriate behaviours, will be given the opportunity to correct their behaviour and if need appropriate behaviour retaught. A classroom tracking system is in place in all classrooms:

GREEN LEVEL: "You are on task! – first verb remain on green if behaviour is corrected. sk" – first verbal reminders/ re-teaching can be given at this level and students

YELLOW LEVEL: If behaviour is not corrected and a second reminder is needed, students will move their name 'Time to change' and be further encouraged to reflect on school values and expectations.

RED LEVEL: If behaviour still is not corrected, students will move their name to receive logical consequences and teacher conferencing. Teachers will record the behaviour on Sentral to track.

Three records on Sentral in a fortnight signal the need for attendance at the Planning Room to work with executive teachers to plan for improving the behaviour.

For MAJOR (see attached list) inappropriate Behaviours, students will...

- . Need to attend Planning Room and possibly receive further consequences.
- For EXTREME (see attached list) inappropriate Behaviours, students will. . Need to be managed immediately by executive or the Principal.
